According to Wespine one of Australia's largest treating plants; the treated pine most commonly available in Australia is either preserved with CCA or ACQ.

- the main benefit for using treated pine is it's a softwood that is light and relatively easy to handle
- once it has been treated, the life expectancy of pine is commonly equal, if not better than most hardwoods

- many view the proliferation of pine plantations as a negative because they displace all the indigenous old growth forests
