

# Replacement Decking Timber At Renovator Auctions Western Sydney

How do you know when you need the decking timber at Renovator Auctions Western Sydney to replace you old decking?

It's easier than you might think.

## **First – examine your decking**

Being aware that damaged or rotting timber decking can be dangerous to walk over, carefully look, or even probe wood for any signs of soft sponginess or structural degradation. These can be a symptom of water seepage, or loss of wood fibres both from infestation or dry rotting. For more information on how to spot them in your decking [click here](#).

Next, look for broken or missing pieces of decking, or decking that has become loose and might even be missing.

Any decking that shows any of the above signs will need replacing.

## **Second – work out if it's worthwhile replacing the whole decking with the new decking timber at Renovator Auctions Western Sydney, or just bits and pieces.**

You'll need to have a good look at costs and figures to work out if you're better off just replacing part of the decking, or the whole decking. There are some really good points to simply replace it all,

1. The replacement decking timber at Renovator Auctions Western Sydney is so cost effective when compared to standard outlets, it can be a lot more affordable than what might you think
2. It's a lot easier to match colours and grains if you use timber from one lot
3. Also, it can be less fiddley to replace a whole deck rather than taking out odd pieces of decking and trying to fit in new ones
4. If you've found the more obvious symptoms of insect infestation and dry rot in your decking, there could be other pieces that are also infected but are in the earlier stages which you might not easily find.

5. Obviously, one of the signs to replace the whole deck is how big an area is affected. A general rule seems to be if there are less than five pieces of decking that needs replacing, then maybe try and source some timber decking that is extremely similar to what has already been used.
6. If you're a mad keen wood master, you'll be able to use leftover pieces of decking for soooo many other projects
